

RING TOSS



Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Paint
- Paper towel tube
- Tape
- Scissors
- Brush



This Ring Toss uses simple everyday materials. If you are wanting a fun, easy to make activity that can provide hours of fun, try this paper plate ring toss.

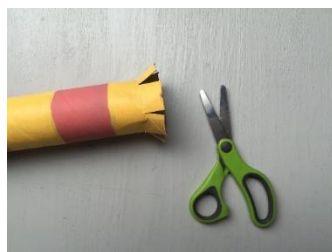
1. Paint the paper tube and top of one plate



2. While the base is drying, start making the tossing rings. You can make any design you want and the more plates you make, the more fun you will have. *You don't need to paint the center of the plate.



3. Check back on the painted base plate and the tube to see if it is dry. Once it is dry, cut 4-6 slits that are a half inch long on the bottom of the tube.



4. Fold the tabs outward and tape them down to the base plate. Your ring toss stand is now complete.



5. Check on the other painted plates- they will be your tossing rings. When they are dry, cut the center out of the plate.



6. Let the games begin. Come up with creative tossing techniques and see how many you can land at once. If your plates are too light for throwing, you can tape two plates together so you can see both painted sides.
